



The maximum dimensions for abnormal transport that **do not require a permit**, according to Decree on the Use of Vehicles on the Road and the Finnish Transport and Communications Agency Traficom's Abnormal Road Transport Regulation. Even if an abnormal transport does not require a permit based on its dimensions, the regulations regarding abnormal transport markings and warning measures must **always** be adhered to.

The general maximum permissible **height of 4.40 m** applies to all vehicle types in this table. Transports higher than this must hold an abnormal transport permit.

Exceeding the load does not affect the granting of the permit within the limits of the above-mentioned clearance dimensions. Excessive loads affect the warning measures. For more detailed information, please refer to sections 5.1 and 7.2 of Traficom's Abnormal Road Transport Regulation.

<sup>1)</sup> A dimension exceeding the vehicle or a dimension generally permissible for the road may only be from an indivisible load.

<sup>2)</sup> Length may be exceeded during loading or unloading if the load has been transported in a trailer.

<sup>3)</sup> A permit available for a maximum width of 4 m and maximum length of 18 m

<sup>4)</sup> A permit available for a maximum width of 4 m

<sup>5)</sup> The permissible length of a combination of a lorry and an actual trailer or a lorry and multiple trailers is 34.50 metres when their width is less than 3.50 metres. If the width exceeds 3.50 metres, the permissible length is 30.00 metres

<sup>6)</sup> The length of the unladen trailer must exceed the generally permissible dimension for the road

<sup>7)</sup> A permit is available for widths up to 4 m, if the trailer is wider than 2.6 m and the load is no more than 1 m wider than the trailer

<sup>8)</sup> The permissible length of a combination of a lorry and towed machine is 30.00 metres
