

Koli–Vuonisolahti ice road



Info

- The Koli–Vuonisolahti ice road is an ice road maintained by the State. Depending on weather conditions, the road is kept open to March/April.
- The length of the ice road is 7 kilometres.
- The journey along the ice road from the village of Koli to the centre of Lieksa is 41 kilometres, by the land road 92 kilometres.
- Ice road opening times are notified, e.g. by information signs – one of which is located 9 km south of the centre of Lieksa on road 5071, and the other at Ahmovaara, Juuka, by road 504.



Points to remember when driving on the ice road

The road has the following restrictions:

- 1) The maximum permitted weight for a vehicle is 3 tonnes.
- 2) The maximum permitted speed is 50 km/h.
- 3) The minimum distance between vehicles is 50 metres.
- 4) Overtaking is prohibited.
- 5) Stopping is prohibited.

If your vehicle comes to a stop on the ice road due to engine failure or other reason, vehicles providing assistance must not stop close to the vehicle to be assisted because of the weight concentrated on the ice.
