


THE AREA OF ELY CENTRE FOR OSTROBOTHNIA

Employment Bulletin February 2025

The unemployment is increasing and the number of open vacancies decreasing in the area of ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia



A total of 8 789 unemployed jobseekers were registered in the area of ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia at the end of February. This is 755 more than the previous year. In February the amount of unemployed people was 269 less than the previous month.

The share of the unemployed jobseekers out of the labour force in the area of ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia is the lowest (7,6 %) in the Mainland Finland. In the whole country the respective share out of the labour force is 12,0 %. Compared with January the unemployment rate decreased by 0,3 per cent in the area of ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia. In the rest of the country the unemployment rate remained unchanged. The figures are from the Employment Service Statistics of the KEHA Centre.


Trends:

- The amount of unemployed was at the end of February 8 789 and 755 more (+ 9,4 %) than the previous year.
- The amount of fulltime laid-off was 792 i.e. 390 less (-33,0 %) than the previous year.
- Also, the amount of young unemployed people increased compared with the situation the year before. The amount of unemployed people under 25 years was 113 more (+ 11,3 %) than the previous year.
- The amount of long-term unemployed increased by 508 persons (+ 24,4 %) compared with the year before.
- The number of new open vacancies in February was 758 less (- 32,6 %) than the previous year.
- The number of people in employment-promoting services decreased compared with the year before. At the end of February the amount of participants in services was in total 3 543.




Unemployed jobseekers

UNEMPLOYED JOBSEEKERS, MONTH BY MONTH COMPARISON






UNEMPLOYED JOBSEEKERS BY AGE GROUP






Unemployed jobseekers by levels of education and occupational group


UNEMPLOYED JOBSEEKERS BY LEVEL OF EDUCATION



UNEMPLOYED JOBSEEKERS BY OCCUPATIONAL GROUP







Information about the website

On this website you will find the latest statistics from ELY Centre for Ostrobothnia's monthly Employment Bulletin. You can access a .pdf version of the current and previous months' Employment Bulletin by following the link on the right.

The Employment Bulletin is based on the data from the KEHA Centre's Employment Service Statistics. The Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment compiles statistics on the clients of the Employment authorities, including registered job-seekers, labour market policy services, and job vacancies. The data is collected from the customer service registries used by the Employment authorities. This means that the data used by MEAE Employment Service Statistics is completely registry-based.

The statistical data covers all persons, services, and open vacancies in the aforementioned groups, as separately defined in the registry by the classifications and variables for the statistical period in question.

Owing to seasonal variations, the Employment Bulletin always includes a comparison with the corresponding month in the previous year. The descriptors used in the Bulletin are also available in a table format. The Employment Bulletins are published at the end of the subsequent calendar month. The official date of publication is announced in advance.
